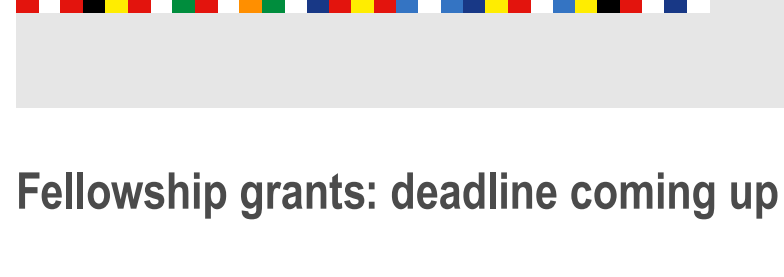
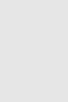




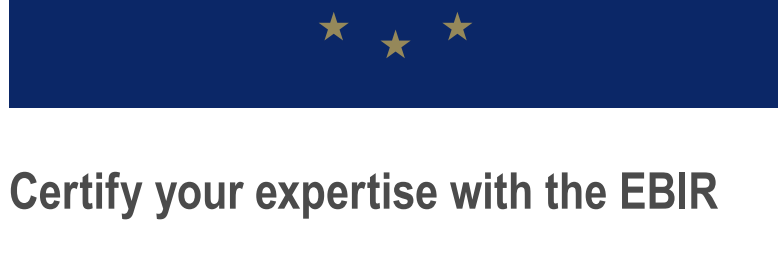
ABSTRACT SUBMISSION FOR CIRSE 2025 HAS BEGUN

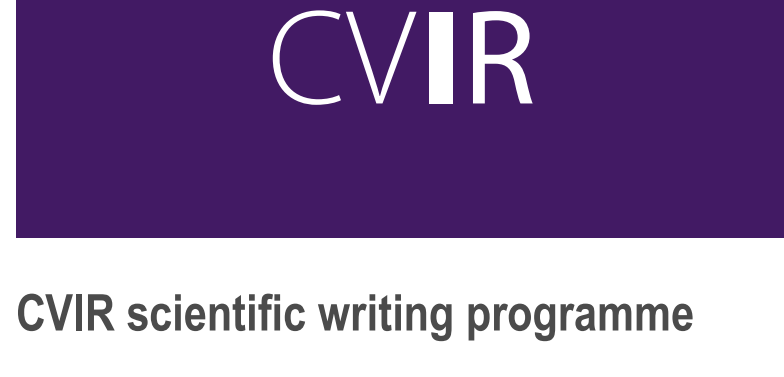
ESIR Course on thyroid ablation

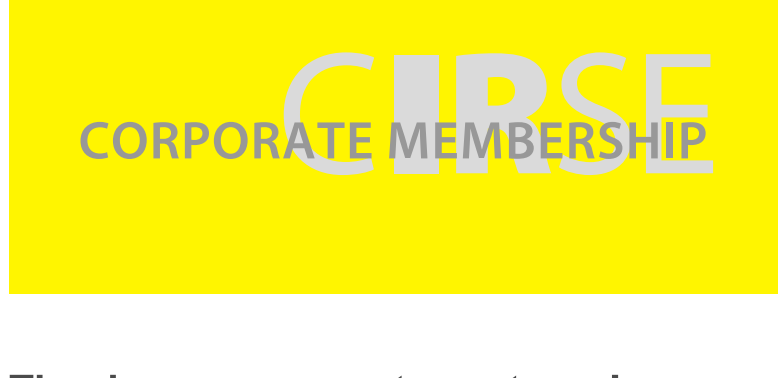


