# Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiological Society of Europe





In line with articles 5.8 and 5.9 of the CIRSE Articles of Association, applicants for fellow and corresponding fellow status must fulfil the criteria set by the Executive Committee and listed in the CIRSE fellow application requirements catalogue. The present catalogue outlines all requirements to be met by future fellows and corresponding fellows. Information on the application process is provided on the CIRSE website.

### **Requirements to be met by future fellows and corresponding fellows**

#### I. Education and membership

Candidates for fellow and corresponding fellow status need to fulfil all requirements outlined below.

- Completion of medical specialty training in radiology and/or interventional radiology, or other relevant medical specialty at least five years ago
- ✓ CIRSE member in good standing for at least three years

#### II. Endorsement

Candidates for fellow and corresponding fellow status need to fulfil all requirements outlined below.

 Have the endorsement of two fellows or one fellow and one corresponding fellow

### III. Academic track record

Candidates for fellow and corresponding fellow status need to fulfil all requirements outlined below.

Published at least five articles on a cardiovascular and interventional radiology topic in internationally recognised peer-reviewed scientific journals with an impact factor, having been the first author of at least one of these five articles. One article must have been published in CVIR or one of CVIR's associated journals with an impact factor. Case reports and letters to the editors are excluded.
